


Main policies map alterations




Map 5. Battle Bridge Place - new open space designation






Map 7. Granary Square - new open space designation







Map 9. King's Cross Square - new open space designation




Map 10. Marchmont Community Garden - new open space designation



Map 11. Pancras Square - new open space designation






Map 14. Belsize Wood Nature Reserve - previous boundary







Map 16. Broadhurst Copse - previous boundary





Map 17. Broadhurst Copse - revised boundary




Map 22. Fitzroy Park Allotments and The Elms, Fitzroy Park - previous boundary




Map 23. Fitzroy Park Allotments and The Elms, Fitzroy Park - revised boundary




Map 24. Harrison Street Wildflower Meadow - previous boundary




Map 25. Harrison Street Wildflower Meadow - revised boundary







Map 28. Kilburn Grange Park - previous boundary




Map 29. Kilburn Grange Park - revised boundary




Map 32. Mill Lane (No. 160)- previous boundary







Map 35. Montpellier Gardens and Montpellier Play Centre - revised boundary




Map 36. Railway Embankment Fordwych Road - previous boundary







Map 38. St Andrew's Gardens - previous boundary




Map 39. St Andrew's Gardens - revised boundary












Map 43. St Giles Churchyard and Playground - revised boundary











Map 47. Sumatra Road Playground - revised boundary








Map 50. Sites of importance for nature conservation (SINCs)






Map 73. Proposed New Local Grade SINC CaBII11 Fitzroy Park allotments


Frontage designations for Town Centres and Central London Areas

The National Planning Policy Framework states that Local Plans should define the extent of town centres and primary shopping areas, based on a clear definition of primary and secondary frontages in designated centres. The Policies Map already shows the boundaries for the Town Centres and Central London Frontages. The following maps show the frontage designations (primary and secondary) to be added to the Policies Map. These frontages were previously defined in Camden Planning Guidance 5 Town Centre, Retail, and Employment (Supplementary Planning Document). A number of minor modifications have been made to the frontage designations from Camden Planning Guidance which have been described below.
